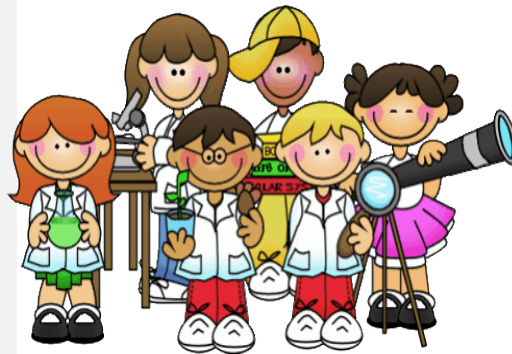
CAREER MONTH
